Top management will review this management system at planned intervals to ensure its continuing suitability, adequacy and effectiveness in satisfying the international standard [ISO 9001] and the organisation's stated policy and objectives. The review process will take account of customer feedback and act as a vehicle for establishing measurable objectives, aimed at satisfying the ongoing requirement for continual improvement.
